



Spokes and Spurs COVID-19 Operational Rules June 30, 2020

- Anyone testing positive for or has had known exposure to COVID-19 within 14 days before the event is expected to not attend.
- All persons temperatures will be checked with a non-touch thermometer as you enter the event area. If the person has any fever, they will be expected to cancel and not attend that day.
- Wash hands thoroughly using the 20 second rule for scrubbing hands. If possible, bring sterile wipes and/or disinfectant to wipe any surfaces that you may touch that is not your own.
- **ALL PERSONS are required to wear masks** except when actually driving or riding. **Masks are to be worn even if you are in your own family/team group.** Anyone not wearing a mask will be requested to leave.
- If you require someone coming in to be your navigator, masks must be worn by the driver and navigator(s) when driving.
- Observe the 6 foot rule (two arms length) of social distancing when moving around anyone not in your immediate group.
- Tacking up will be at your trailer. Do not enter barns or facilities on the property unless you have been given clearance.
- There will be no group food events such as potlucks or barbecues. No food will be sold at activities. Family groups may bring their own food, but are not to share it with others.
- When watering areas are provided, participants are to bring their own hoses to limit contact.
- Any event observers must wear masks at all times and observe the 6 foot rule of social distancing. Observers are not allowed to congregate.
- We will have need for volunteers, but limited to essential operating personnel. All volunteers must wear masks. Depending on the contact situation, volunteers/ personnel may be furnished and must use other equipment such as gloves, special masks, etc.
- There will be no in-person group meetings until further notice. Group meetings may be held through telephone conferencing, texting, or ZOOM meetings.
